As a follow-up, send students some sentence transformations to do. Also, encourage them to choose a sentence from a clip or audio recording and listen to it as many times as they need to in order to write it down (like step 1).

Ask which FCE/CAE exercise the one in the previous step reminded them of. Any differences? (In FCE, use two to five words, and in CAE, three to six.)

Ask how many people heard the sentence. Now they're going to express it in different ways. Display the sentences on page 2. Tell them to complete the second sentence so that it has a similar meaning to the first one, using the word given. Each gap is one word.
